What exactly is Faith?

No matter what you believe in, you will have to believe it by faith. Whether you believe there is a God or if you believe in the Big Bang, you will have to believe in it by faith because you cannot prove or disprove it; all you can do is accept it or deny it. And both arguments are just as valid. But, just because you don't believe something does not mean it does not exist.

Hebrews 11:1

Now faith is being sure of what we hope for and certain of what we do not see.

Let's take God for example. If you have had a born again experience with God, and your spirit has connected with the Holy Spirit, you KNOW that God is real. That is why so many martyrs have died for their belief. That is faith. You have not seen God, you cannot prove that he exists, but by faith, you know that he does. This is what this scripture means.

Romans 10:17

Consequently faith comes from hearing the message, and the message is heard through the word of Christ.

Before I heard about Jesus I was an atheist. Then I read about Jesus. I could not believe it right away, but as I heard and read more, faith came and I believed. This is how the Holy Spirit works in our lives. The more we read the Word of God, the more he helps us understand it.

It's hard to stay "up" when you are down, but then when the breakthrough comes, we rejoice. James says that is the testing of our faith. And the next time it is not as bad, because you know from experience that God will come through for you, he always has and always will.

Jesus first taught us about faith. Faith in him. If we believe in Jesus, we do so by faith. That is why he is the author of faith. As he works in our life and leads us through the trials and temptations of life, our faith grows. I remember when I was a new Christian and heard some of the things that other Christians believed God for, I couldn't believe it. That's because my faith was new, they had many experiences with God and could trust him for bigger things than I could at the time.

Matthew 17:20

...I tell you the truth, if you have faith as small as a mustard seed, you can say to this mountain "Move from here to there" and it will move. Nothing will be impossible for you.

I must admit I still have trouble with this scripture. I still don't have that kind of faith. It's not that I don't believe Jesus; it's just that I can't get it in my head. Yes, God has moved some "mountains" for me in my time, but I still need his help to do it.

James 2:14-17 & 26

What good is it, my brothers, if a man claims to have faith but has no deeds? Can such faith save him? Suppose a brother or sister is without clothes and daily food. If one of you says to him, "Go, I wish you well; keep warm and well fed," but does nothing about his physical needs, what good is it? In the same way, faith by itself, if it is not accompanied by action, is dead. As the body without the spirit is dead, so faith without deeds is dead.

Faith cannot work if you just think about it. You also have to do something to show that you really do believe it is going to happen. Let me give you an example. I wanted to go into a trade show once, but when I called them they had no space available. I asked them to put me on the waiting list. Reluctantly they did but said it was very unlikely I could get in. I prayed about it, and told God that I really wanted to get into that trade show. Then I started making my booth and getting my displays ready. A few hours before the show opened, they called me and said they had found a place for me. If I had not been ready, I could not have done it, but by faith in God, I was and I Praised the Lord for what he did for me.

John 14:12

I tell you the truth, anyone who has faith in me will do what I have been doing. He will do even greater things than these because I am going to the Father. And I will do whatever you ask in my name so that the Son may bring glory to the Father. You may ask me for anything in my name, and I will do it.

If we read the accounts of what Jesus' disciples did after he was resurrected, they did what he was doing by healing the sick, feeding the hungry, and teaching the people about

God. Jesus says, it's not that you will be doing it, I will do whatever you ask me for, just ask in my name and I will do it for you.

Hebrews 11:6

And without faith it is impossible to please God, because anyone who comes to him must believe that he exists and that he rewards those who earnestly seek him.

In Hebrews Chapter 11 we see the faith of Abraham, Noah, Issac, Jacob, Joseph, Moses, and other men of God. These examples show us how much they put their faith in God.
